

About the Conductor

Mr. Lee has done considerable work as a marching band clinician and is considered to be one of the leading authorities on this subject. He has served as adjudicator for many state contests and festivals, and also conducted many all-state bands and festivals.

He has been given credit for developing a new marching technique known as "Eight to the Five." This system of measuring the marching pace by taking eight steps to every five yards has created new possibilities of alignment and timing. As assistant director of the University of Michigan Band, he introduced several new elements of marching and dancing for bands. While a student at Ohio State University and arranger for the Ohio State Band, Mr. Lee and Professor Whitcomb originated the six-voice marching arrangements. Since coming to the University of Arizona, Mr. Lee has published many charts using his 64-inch charting system, which is gradually replacing the 30-inch system for charting. He has also developed a series of new facings for bandmen, which is being adopted throughout the nation. His work with the Michigan Band received national recognition through an 8-page spread in Life Magazine, and through an RKO motion picture, "Here Comes The Band." The University of Arizona Band which he directs is considered by many authorities to be one of the best in the nation.
