The musical career of Leonard B. Smith, famous cornet soloist and trumpeter, provides a constant standard of comparison and inspiration for aspiring young musicians everywhere.

Leonard Smith is an all-American product. He gained his musical training under such men as Ernest S. Williams, Mayhew L. Lake, Erik Leidzen, Rosario Scalero and Pierre Henrotte. He attended the public schools in Poughkeepsie, New York, won a scholarship at the New York Military Academy, attended the Ernest Williams School of Music, New York University and the Curtis Institute. For three and a half years, he served in the United States Navy and now directs and solos with his own band.

In a logical, methodical and intelligent approach to the practical problems confronting cornet and trumpet players, he has presented a wealth of invaluable information for all students.
