White Bear Lake, Minnesota

John Zdechlik is a native of Minneapolis, Minnesota. He was born in 1937 and studied piano during his early years. While in high school, he became interested in jazz and soon began writing arrangements for local jazz bands. During these years he began studying trumpet and soon was busy as a professional performer and writer in the Twin Cities area. This background lead him to a career in music and in 1957 he began his studies in music at the University of Minnesota.

After teaching for two years at the secondary level, Zdechlik returned to school to study composition with composer Paul Fetler at the University of Minnesota. During this time he also worked as an associate with Frank Berncriscutto, Director of Bands, at Minnesota. In 1970 he received a PhD in theory and composition.

Since 1970 Zdechlik has had numerous works commissioned and published. His music is frequently performed by high school and college groups throughout this country, as well as abroad.

Zdechlik teaches theory and conducts the College Bands at Lakewood Community College, White Bear Lake, Minnesota. He is active as a guest conductor and lecturer throughout the country.

# ALTERNATES FOR SOUTH DAKOTA ALL-STATE BAND

Students are selected for All-State Band by a competitive audition held in nine cities. This year 900 students registered to be auditioned for positions in the All-State Band. It is likely that there will be some with the same audition score as those who are in the Band. The following considerations are used in breaking tie scores:

1. Former members.
2. Former alternates.
3. A student whose school is not represented is given first preference.
4. Upper-classmen are given preference over under-classmen.
5. If none of the above criteria applies, the audition judges break the tie.
