DR. JAMES JURRENS
Chairman of the Music Department
and Director of Bands
Southwestern State University
Weatherford, Oklahoma

Dr. James Jurrens is Chairman of the Music Department and Director of Bands at Southwestern State University, Weatherford, Oklahoma. He has held this position since 1970. His past teaching experience includes twelve years in public schools as well as the University of South Dakota at Springfield, Dakota Wesleyan University in South Dakota, and Minot State College in North Dakota.

Dr. Jurrens has composed and arranged twelve publications which have been published by Jenson Publications, Carl Fisher and Southern Music Publishing Company.

Under his leadership the Southwestern State University Bands have grown to over 200 and the Wind Symphony, the top select band has gained national recognition. The Wind Symphony is composed of a select group of 72 musicians. They have performed for the Music Educators National Conference in Omaha, Nebraska, and Colorado Springs. They have also appeared for the College Bandmasters in Albuquerque, New Mexico as well as numerous other conventions.

The Wind Symphony cut seven albums of rare marches and this year will make their eighth album. They have also cut album one and two for Crest Records of New York. This is in connection with Crest Records Authenticated Composers Series. They have done the music of Claude T. Smith for this series. The albums are available from Crest Records.

At present he serves as the Southwest District Chairman for the National Band Association. He is also president elect of OMEA.

ALTERNATES FOR SOUTH DAKOTA ALL-STATE BAND

Students are selected for All-State Band by a competitive audition held in nine cities. This year 875 students registered to be auditioned for positions in the All-State Band. It is likely that there will be some with the same audition score as those who are in the Band. The following considerations are used in breaking tie scores:

1. Former members.
2. Former alternates.
3. A student whose school is not represented is given first preference.
4. Upper-classmen are given preference over under-classmen.
5. If none of the above criteria applies, the audition judges break the tie.
