## ALL-STATE BAND BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The members of the All-State Band were selected by auditioning at one of the eight audition centers throughout the State. The four audition judges fly around the State to each site over a period of six days and listen to students. From that number the 172 students that are in this year's band were selected. The members of the Band represent 49 South Dakota schools. There are 76 seniors, 52 juniors, 32 sophomores and 12 freshmen in the band.

## GUEST CONDUCTOR



**Dr. Robert C. Fleming**

Dr. Robert C. Fleming, is Professor of Music, Associate Director of Bands and Director of the Sun Devil Marching Band at Arizona State University. He has degrees from Indiana University of Pennsylvania, Carnegie-Mellon University, and Southern Illinois University (Doctor of Philosophy in Secondary Education). His Arizona State University Sun Devil Marching Band received the 1991 Sudler Trophy distinguishing it as one of the most outstanding marching band programs in the country. He also conducts the ASU Concert Band, and the Sun Devil Basketball Pep Band. Prior to his arrival at Arizona State University in 1974, he was Director of Bands at the University of Tennessee at Martin, Tennessee for seven years.

In addition to his duties at Arizona State University, Professor Fleming is an active marching and concert band clinician, adjudicator, and a member of numerous professional organizations. He served on the Board of Directors of the American Bandmasters Association from 1990 to 1993. He is Past President of the PAC 10 Band Directors Association and Past National President of the National Band Honorary Fraternity, Kappa Kappa Psi. He currently continues to serve the fraternity as Chairman of the Board of Trustees. In 1989, Dr. Fleming was installed as an honorary member of Alpha chapter of Phi Beta Mu, the International Bandmasters Fraternity. In 1993, Dr. Fleming received the Bohumil Makovsky Memorial Award to Outstanding College Band Directors from Kappa Kappa Psi and in September 1994, he received the Professional Fraternity Association's 1994 Faculty Award of Excellence.

## SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS

During this evening's concert various special presentations will be made. Included in these presentations will be a SDHSAA "Distinguished Service" Award and the induction of two individuals into the SDBA "Hall of Fame".

### SOUTH DAKOTA BANDMASTERS HALL OF FAME

#### S. Kenneth Lotspeich

Before moving to South Dakota, S. Kenneth Lotspeich taught at Fairfield, Superior, Grand Island, and Kearney in Nebraska. In 1948, he assumed the duties as instructor of all music education courses, band and choir director at General Beadle State College (now Dakota State University). He directed bands there until 1961. He directed the choir until 1972 when he retired.

In 1948 he became a charter member of the SDMEA. He served as the second president of the organization in 1949. He also sponsored the chapter if MENC at the college.

But his music influences were not limited to only the college level. He was instrumental in organizing the first South Dakota High School All-State Orchestra. He served as woodwind adjudicator for All-State Band for the first seven years of auditions. He served as the Secretary-Treasurer of the District II Music Contest for the SDHSAA for 35 years and he served as Music Contest Manager for 34 years for the SD Bandmasters Association.

Professor Lotspeich was also active in civic affairs. He established the Madison Community Chorus in 1958 and was its director until retirement in 1972. He established the Madison Kiwanis Chorus in 1962. He served as President of the Madison Music Concert Association for several terms and was board member from 1949-1972. In addition to all of this, he directed his church choir for 23 years.

He served as Retired Teachers Chairperson for the SDMEA. In 1982, he was honored by this same organization in recognition for 51 years of distinguished service to young people and devotion to music education.

### SDHSAA DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD & SOUTH DAKOTA BANDMASTERS HALL OF FAME



#### Harold E. Krueger

Dr. Krueger joined the Augustana College Music Department staff in 1965. In his position as Professor of Music he directed the brass activities of the department. He was also director of the Northlanders Jazz Band (20 years) and introduced the prestigious "JAZZ ON THE UPPER GREAT PLAINS" festival to the quad-state area. He was the conductor of the Augustana Brass Choir for 28 years and Chair of the Department of Music for the final years of his career at Augustana College.

Dr. Krueger is a native of Redwood Falls, Minnesota. He received his BA degree from Luther College (Decorah, Iowa) and his masters and doctorate from the University of Northern Colorado (Greeley). His public school teaching experience includes both instrumental and choral teaching in Calmar and Britt, Iowa,

and in Glencoe, Minnesota. His previous college experience was at St. Cloud (Minnesota) State University.

Dr. Krueger's performing groups were invited to play for three North Central conventions of the Music Educators National Conference, two in-service meetings of the South Dakota Music Educators as well as three meetings of the New York Brass Conference. The Augustana Brass Choir has toured Europe on five occasions as well as appearances at Orchestra Hall in Minneapolis on two occasions and at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C.

Dr. Krueger is past president of the South Dakota Music Educators Association, the South Dakota Alliance for Arts Education as well as past state band chair for the National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors and past chair of the Midwest division of the National Band Association. In 1971 he received the honor of being the first person in South Dakota to receive the "Citation of Excellence Award" from the National Band Association and in 1980 received the prestigious "Carlo A. Sperati Award" from Luther College. In 1989 he received the "Burlington Northern Excellence in Teaching Award" from Augustana College. He was also the recipient of the "Outstanding Achievement in Music Award" from Phi Beta Mu in 1988. In 1995 he received the "Outstanding Alumnus Award" from Luther College. He is much in demand as a guest conductor, soloist and adjudicator/clinician in the upper Midwest and has served for over 25 years in summer music camps notably at the International Music Camp, Rushmore Music Camp, Purdue Band Camp, Dorian Music Camp and the South Dakota All-State Music Camp. He has been one of the adjudicators for the South Dakota All-State Band for 13 years.

Dr. Krueger retired from formal teaching in July of 1993 but still maintains an active brass studio and continues with adjudication, trumpet performance and seminar assignments throughout the upper Midwest.
