Matt's first big band CD recorded by the Kluver's big band from Aahrus, Denmark featuring many of Matt's original tunes and arrangements will be available by the end of the summer. Matt is currently Director of Jazz Studies at California State University Northridge, directing the award winning Jazz "A" band and teaching jazz arranging, improvisation, combos, jazz harmony, class piano, and private piano instruction. Matt often performs as a guest soloist and clinician at various universities and high schools. He has recently performed and conducted bands in New Zealand, Denmark and China.
