Scott Prebys serves as Director of Percussion Studies/Chairman of the Department of Music at the University of Mary in Bismarck, North Dakota. He directs the University of Mary Steel Band and the Percussion Group and also teaches jazz studies. Under his direction, the UMARY Jazz Ensemble has made two appearances at the famed Montreaux Jazz Festival and recently released a CD on the Sea Breeze label with special guest trumpet artist Bob Montgomery. Scott has an extensive performance background and is a frequent clinician throughout the Midwest.

Michael B. Nelson, trombone, has distinguished himself as the leader, composer, arranger, and trombonist for the internationally acclaimed, 5-piece, a cappella jazz horn group, the HORNHEADS. From 1991-2001 Nelson and the Hornheads recorded and toured worldwide with Prince. Nelson also composed horn arrangements for Prince and co-wrote a song on his Grammy-nominated "Gold Experience" CD. In 1996 Nelson received the McKnight Fellowship through the American Composers Forum. He has appeared on over 100 CD's including three Hornheads solo releases, "Fat Lip", "5 Heads Are Better Than 1", and "Hornheads" and 20 recordings with Prince and his associated Paisley Park artists. Nelson also performed and/or recorded with Doc Severinsen, Chaka Khan, Lenny Kravitz, Sammy Davis Jr., Mandy Moore, Jimmy Jam, Larry Graham, Ben Sidran, Babyface, Maceo Parker, and many others.
