About our Guest Artist

Don Owens, Associate Professor of Conducting and Director of the National High School Music Institute at Northwestern University, received degrees from North Texas State University and the University of Illinois. Before coming to Northwestern in 1979, he taught for twelve years at Evanston Township High School where his duties included directing band, brass ensembles and jazz band, as well as teaching music theory, composition and electronic music. At Northwestern, Mr. Owens is director of the Jazz Ensembles Curriculum and conductor of the outstanding University Jazz Ensemble. Owens is also Director of the Contemporary Music Ensemble. He is author of several articles dealing with contemporary music and composition and has had many of his compositions published. He is a member of M.E.N.C., Illinois Music Educators Association, International Association of Jazz Educators, College Band Directors National Association, Pi Kappa Lambda, and Phi Mu Alpha.

About the All State Jazz Ensembles

The South Dakota All State Jazz Ensemble Festival is in its fourth year. The two ensembles consist of South Dakota's most talented high school jazz musicians. Membership in the two bands is based upon a taped audition, with each applicant's tape being judged for musicality, style, technique and jazz improvisation by a group of adjudicators who are specialists in the field of jazz education.

The successful musicians are assembled for three days of intensive rehearsals with a nationally known guest artist/clinician to prepare the concert which caps each year's festival.
